

Barbera, Renwood 2006, California 4/8/26
The wine displays aromas of rhubarb, cherry, and strawberry. On the palate the wine is lighter, with a smooth core of fruit flavors. Crisp acidity is Barbara's signature trait which makes this wine so mouthwatering. A finish that lingers, with raspberry flavors with a hint of cinnamon, balances the wine.

Blend, Baqueano 2008 Cab/Malbec, Patagonia 3/6 /20
A blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Malbec from Argentina's Patagonia region, this exciting 2008 is amazing with its high tones of berries and fresh plum fruit. Well balanced and structured with soft tannins and a long finish.

Blend, Wolf Trap 2008, South Africa 4/7/22
The Syrah in the blend leads to the spicy, aromatic nose of the wine, supported by perfume from the Viognier component. A more peppery note is most likely due to the co-fermentation of some of the Syrah and Viognier. The Mourvedre adds structure and weight to the palate with good density. A good introduction to South African Wines.

Blend, Rock Point 2008 River Rock Red, Rogue River, Oregon 4/7/22
This is a deep, dark colored wine exhibiting aromas of red fruit, ripe cherry, forest, and vanilla. Flavors of plum, olive, eucalyptus and spice are present. Full bodied, with large round tannins, it finishes long and dry.

Blend, Sanguinetti 2005 Super Tuscan, Italy 5/10/32
The Merlot is intensely floral and elegant, while the Sangiovese is fresh and bright. The Syrah adds depth and body, offering a bold expression of forest-floor truffle, ripe cherry and blackberry preserves. A harmonious, beautiful wine a true Super Tuscan!

Blend, Goose Ridge 2006 "G3", Washington 6/11/36
All estate grown fruit... a beautiful blend of 49% Syrah 35% Merlot 16% Malbec. Full bodied wine with deep garnet color and a lavish richness. Blackberry and dark cherry flavors blend with vanilla and toasty oak notes to create a round intense mouthfeel. Double Gold Seattle Wine Awards.

Blend, Alexandria Nicole 2007 Quarry Butte, Horse Heaven Hills, Washington 7/14/44
Quarry Butte is an elegantly expressive five varietal blend that packs a punch for the value, capturing the unique territory of Destiny Ridge. It is loaded with aromatics of vanilla, dried herbs, and ripe with berry flavors, rich tannins, hints cedar and elegant oak-spice that lead to a balanced structure and lengthy finish. Katie's # 1 referral wine.

Blend, Allegrini 2005 Palazzo della torre, Italy 7/14/45
An irresistibly stylish wine, opulent and generous, loaded with jammy dark cherries, chocolate, spices and sweet toasted oak. A blend of 70% Corvina Veronese, 25% Rondinella and 5% Sangiovese. 30% of the blend is Amarone!!

Blend, Perrin & Fils 2007 "Les Cornuds", Vinsobres, France 7/13/42
Deep ruby with a purple edge. The syrah grape shows on the nose, with red fruit, black cherry and licorice. On the palate this combines power with elegance, with its velvety, fleshy texture. The finish shows the lift typical of the cooler parts of the Rhône valley.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Dante 2007, California 3/6/20
This Cabernet has lovely black currant, blackberry and black cherry notes. The fruitiness is complimented by rich sweet oak. You've got to try it.

Cabernet, Root:1 2007 Chile 4/8/26
The hot and dry climate of the Colchagua Valley is world renowned for producing concentrated Cabernets of exceptional quality. Root:1 is known for its rich ruby color with tastes of black cherry, full plum and soft vanilla and toffee notes. The silky tannins and good structure support a long complex finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Amavi Cellars 2007, Walla Walla Valley 10/19/60
Aromas of black cherries, blackberries and dusty rose petals are complemented by a hint of cedar. Layers of dark fruits, mixed wild berries and dark chocolate are married with vibrant hints of herbs and spices. This 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon is precociously sophisticated.

Chianti, Villa da Filicaja 2006 Superiore DCG, Italy 4/8/26
Produced from classic chianti grapes, 90% Sangiovese and 10% Canaiolo, this has fresh lively cherry fruit flavors with enticing spice tones. Delicious acidity would make this a great match with our lasagna or mac-n-cheese.

Grenache, Xiloca 2007, Spain 5/9/30
Pronounced "chiloca". Firm and muscular with gripping tannins balanced by low-yield fruit concentration and pronounced minerality, a unique wine with special appeal to those who normally prefer the denser structure of Cabernet or Syrah. Bright red fruits with forest floor earthiness, think Pinot Noir on steroids. Alison love, love, loves this wine.

Malbec, Trumpeter 2007 Mendoza, Argentina 4/7/22
Inky and dense with attractive berry aromas and a touch of cinnamon and sweet spice. A fully, fruity wine, with excellent body, intense tannins, flavors of cherry, blackberry, boysenberry and plum intermingled with hints of cardamom and pepper, and a long, full finish.

Merlot, One Hope 2007, California 4/7/22
50% of profits of all One Hope Wine goes to the designated charity. Internationally, the merlot grape has been a cornerstone in wine making. AIDS is arguably the biggest epidemic in the world, taking the lives of over 25 million people in the last 25 years. Our Merlot is a rich garnet color, with flavors of black cherries, plums, and figs, with a soft, smooth finish. A portion of the blend was oak aged to add subtle toast and vanilla accents.

Merlot, Royal Bitch 2008, Chile 4/8 /26
This merlot has well-integrated spice notes, red cherry and berry fruit and vanilla. Lively red color and supple tannins hold together in the long, focused finish. Our #1 selling wine on the menu - could it be the name? Try it, you will surely ask for seconds.

Pinot Noir, Yealands , New Zealand 6/11/35
This elegant Pinot Noir exudes fresh cherry and spiced red fruit characters with an underlying savoury note. The palate is soft and supple with soft silky tannins.

Pinot Noir, Broadly 2008, Willamette Valley 8/16/50
Layered flavors of succulent Bing cherry and raspberry are highlighted with spice and earth notes and complemented by a finish with excellent depth and balancing acidity.

Shiraz, Yalumba 2007 "Y Series", Australia, 4/7/24
Co-fermented with 6% Viognier, this has an enticing perfume of violets, spice box, and blueberry. This leads to a medium-bodied wine with a smooth-texture, sweet fruit, good depth and concentration, and a fruit-filled finish.

Syrah-The Girl Next Door, Oooh la la Syrah, 2006, Washington 6/11/24
Deep blackish-ruby hue. Smoky, warming licorice and black fruit aromas show lots of ripeness and a generous oak accent. A soft entry leads a weighty, full-bodied palate with ripe flavors and chewy tannins. A chunky heavyweight to enjoy with hearty foods. WORLD WINE CHAMPIONSHIPS AWARD: Silver Medal

Zinfandel, Sobon 2007 Rocky Top, California 6/11/36
Organic. A rich example of the lovely "Amador" Zinfandel style. The aromas are reminiscent of ripe blackberries, cherries, and cocoa. This wine is a perfect match for roasts, steak, and rich sauces, and will complement aged, full flavored cheeses.

Blend, Clayhouse 2008 Adobe White, California 5/10/32

A delicious white blend, incorporating a little known grape called "Princess". Pear, peach and honeydew melon aromas jump from the glass. The mouthwatering fruit flavors are of apple and stone fruit, with nuances of pumpkin pie spice and tea.

Chardonnay, Man 2008, South Africa 3/6/20

With a lovely round mouthful and enticing aromas of citrus, peach and crisp apple, this chardonnay outperforms others in its price category. We love its "old world style". Minerality is balanced by "new world" fruit. Yum!

Chardonnay, One Hope 2007, California 4/7/22

50% of profits of all One Hope Wine goes to the designated charity.

As the perfect pairing to fight breast cancer, it's no secret that Chardonnay is the overwhelming favorite varietal among women. In fact, women prefer Chardonnay two to one over any other varietal. Chardonnay, Independent Producers 2008, Washington 4/7/24

Very classy style with excellent aromatics and texture. 100% stainless steel, no oak, perfectly integrated with notes of pineapple, apple, pear and notes of honey. A beautiful expression of pure Chardonnay fruit. Made by Hedges Winery.

Chenin Blanc, Les Pouches 2008, France 4/7/24

This beautiful single-vineyard white has fresh peach and a faint touch of citrus, as well as a characteristic mineral taste, credited to the unique chalky soil. All highlighted by chenin blanc's signature tangy acidity that gives the wine brightness and a special affinity to salads. Delicious!

Pinot Grigio, Buried Cane 2008, Washington 4/8 /34

This has fragrant aromas combining citrus, thyme and rosemary, tangerine, pear and white peach. A lively entry and a creamy mouthfeel expand with layers of lime, tangerine, pear and white peach, finishing with some honeydew melon flavors.

Riesling, Yalumba 2008 "Y Series", Australia 4/8/26

Bright and bone dry, this Riesling is lively, with a juicy edge to the fragrant grapefruit, lime and apple flavors, lingering gently on the dry finish. From sustainably farmed vineyards, also Vegan friendly.

Riesling, Alexandria Nicole 2008 Late Harvest, Washington 6/11/34

This rich, pleasantly off-dry, deep golden Late Harvest Riesling expresses luscious dried apricot, lemon peel and baked apple aroma. Its balanced acidity and sweetness make this a beautiful wine. Lisa never thought she liked Riesling until she tasted this beauty!

Sauvignon Blanc, Yealands 2008, New Zealand 5/9/30

Lifted citrus and fresh herb aromas, underpinned by classic Seaview vineyard characteristics of mineral, nettle and wet stone. A refined, intense wine with generous fruit and an elegant texture.

Viura, Bodegas Franco 2007 "Rinsol", Rioja Spain 4/7/24

100% Viura grape from the Rioja region of Spain, this is a lovely, dry, fresh and fruity white wine that faintly reminds of green golden apples. A perfect match for salads and light foods. Check out the cool blue bottle.

Viognier, Penner Ash 2007 Willamette Valley, Oregon 7/13/42

An abundance of custard with a hint of citrus, melon and red pear on the nose. Creamy oily texture of layered tropical fruit complements a sweet finish of Asian pear and apricot.

Moscato d'Asti, Vietti 2008 "Cascinetta", Italy 4/8/26 (half-bottle)

A lovely wine with floral notes and honey, it is sweet - but not overly so, balanced with delicious acidity and gentle bubbles. Lovely match with fresh fruits or croissants/scones.

Muscat, Yalumba NV Museum Reserve, Australia 7/13/42

This glorious "history in a bottle" is medium amber with a superb bouquet of honey, ginger, candied apricots, and peach. Ripe, sweet, and hedonistic, it has a very long finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Port, Justin 2007 "Obtuse", California 6/12/38

A bittersweet chocolate note accentuates jammy fruit aromas of raspberry, sweet cherry and plum. The wine is lush and sumptuous on the palate with chocolate, cherry and rich plum flavors.

Brut, Mountain Dome NV, Washington 6/11/36

Specializing in Sparkling Wine, Mountain Dome is located in Spokane, WA. This delicious, every day, méthode champenoise is crisp and fleshy, with green apple flavors. Fruit-driven, it has good punch and persistence, and a clean and refreshing finish.

Brut, Duval-Leroy "Cuvee Paris" NV, Champagne, France 13/25/75

Duval-Leroy is set to make a splash with this bold, artistic "Paris" bottle, silk-screened by artist Leroy Neiman. The champagne has scents of honeysuckle, hazelnut and vanilla leading into a fresh, flavorful and persistent middle. Enticing spice notes roll around the tongue, keeping the flavors lively and interesting.

Zinfandel, Turley 2006 Old Vines, California \$70

Rich full-bodied, and unctuously textured, it explodes from the glass revealing black fruits, earth, kirsch, licorice, pepper, and underbrush elements. Sweet (from glycerin and high alcohol, not sugar), dry, full-bodied, concentrated, hedonistic, and supple.

Chardonnay, Cakebread Cellars, 2008 Napa Valley, California \$90

This Chardonnay displays fresh, fragrant aromas of ripe yellow apple, peach and sweet melon, with subtle hints of toasty oak, vanilla cream and mineral adding complexity. On the rich, round palate, luscious, creamy flavors of peach and ripe apple are balanced by bright acidity, with a refreshing mineral tone enlivening the long, crisp finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Pepperbridge 2005 Walla Walla Valley, Washington \$120

Gorgeous aromas explode from the glass, a lush mix of flower, berry, mocha and sweet earth. Smooth and silky on the tongue, it's a riot of berry and cassis flavor, all in proportion and moving gracefully across the palate and into a round, detailed finish with whiffs of smoke, caramel and coffee grounds.

Cabernet Sauvignon Oak, 2004, Napa, California \$210

The 2004 Napa Cabernet Sauvignon beautifully expresses the full aromatic ripeness of this exemplary vintage. It is full bodied and yet refined, and consistent in its color, aroma, palate and finish. It has a dark garnet color and a nose of black cherry, clove, cinnamon, lavender and licorice. It is seamless on the palate with a solid core of berry fruit, velvety tannins and excellent length.

Brunello di Montalcino, Argiano 2004, Italy \$120

94 points in The Wine Spectator: Delivers raisins, blackberries and roses on the nose. Full-bodied, with a soft and silky tannin structure and a long and delicious finish. This is the best Brunello ever from here. Best from 2010 through 2016.
